



#### Euribor rates











#### Interest rates on new business to households







Linked to base rate








#### Outstanding loans to households and non-financial corporations



# Listed shares in Finland: total market capitalization and non-residents' holdings





#### Non-residents' portfolio investments in Finland

- -Finnish bonds and money market paper, net purchases





#### Mutual funds registered in Finland



#### **Non-financial corporate sector and household borrowing** 1 = corporate sector (excl. housing corporations), 2 = households.









#### Sectoral debt ratios in Finland






#### **Competitiveness indicators for Finland**





#### Finland's imports of goods



#### **Construction indicators**





Industrial investment prospects, (right-hand scale)





#### Harmonized index of consumer prices (HICP)





#### Hourly labour costs




