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


- Marginal lending rate (liquidity credit rate until end-1998)


## **Euribor rates**

#### International three-month interest rates






## International long-term interest rates



Note: Yield on ten-year government bonds.



## Euro area (Finland's) yield curve















- Deposits of euro area residents with euro area MFIs












## Selected stock price indices in the euro area



Finnish bonds and money market paper, net purchases







## Mutual funds registered in Finland




## Borrowing by sector in Finland



Household sector





 Euro's effective exchange rate



## **Competitiveness indicators for Finland**






## Industrial confidence indicator







## Finland's imports of goods





## **Consumption in Finland**


Private consumption (left-hand scale)



### **Fixed investment in Finland**



- Industrial investment prospects, (right-hand scale)



## Finland's exports by industry





## Harmonized index of consumer prices (HICP)









- General government net lending

#### **Public sector debt in Finland**


