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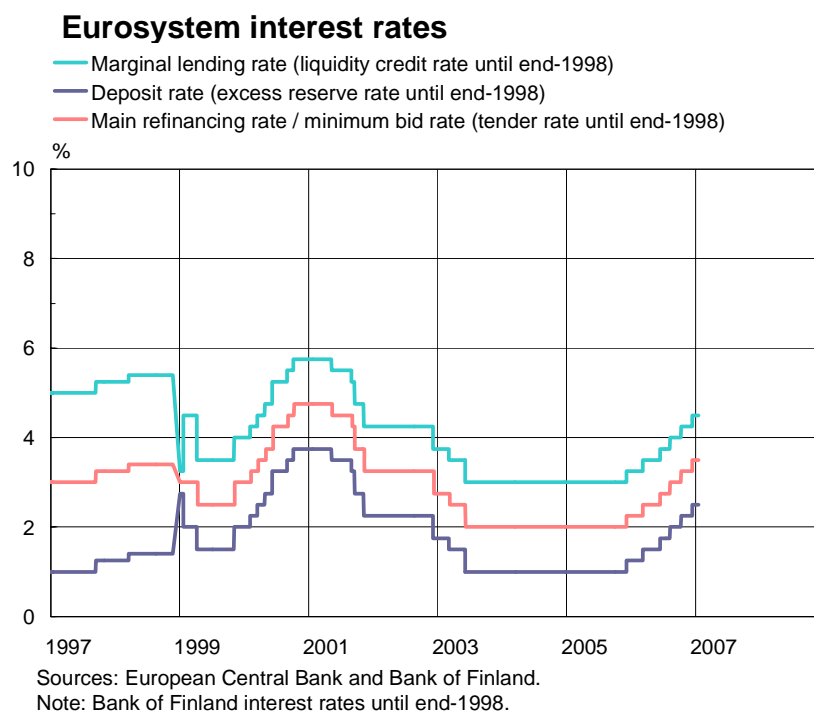

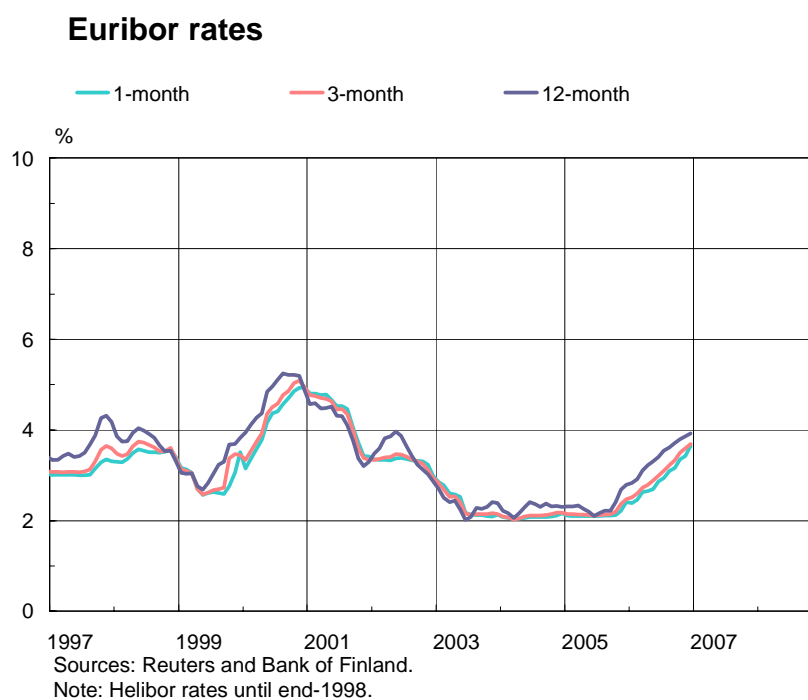
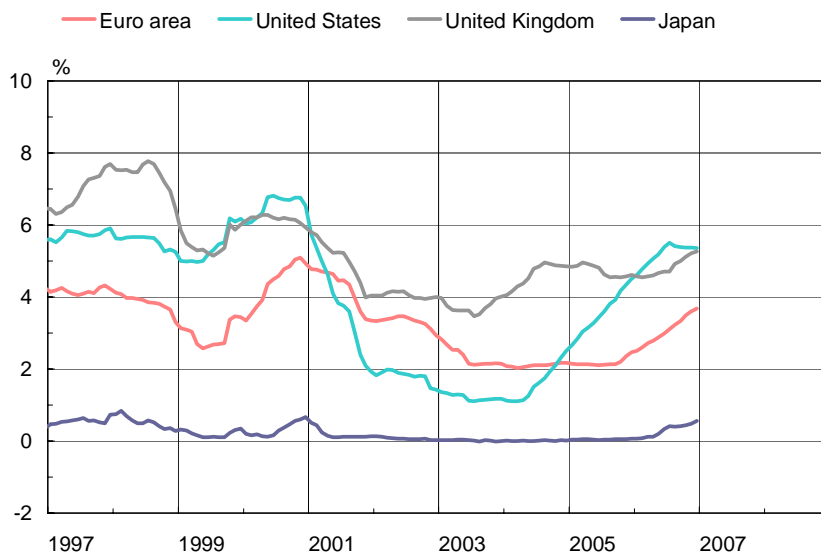


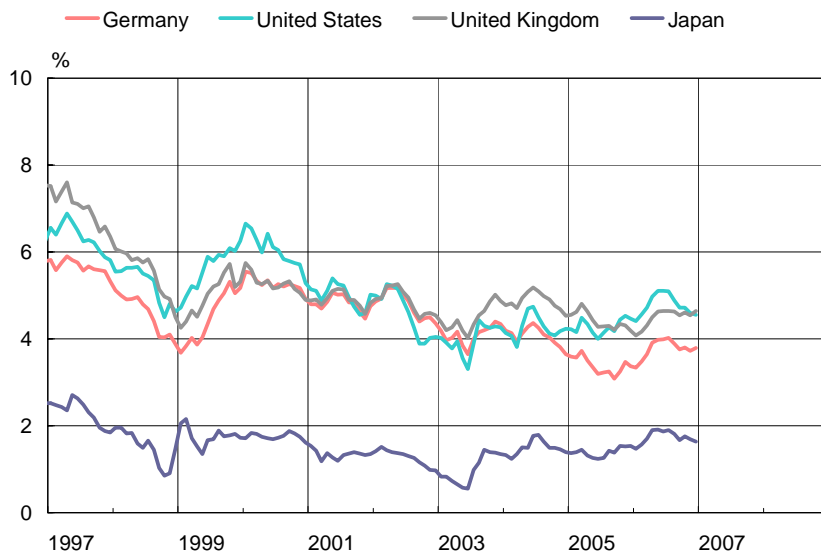

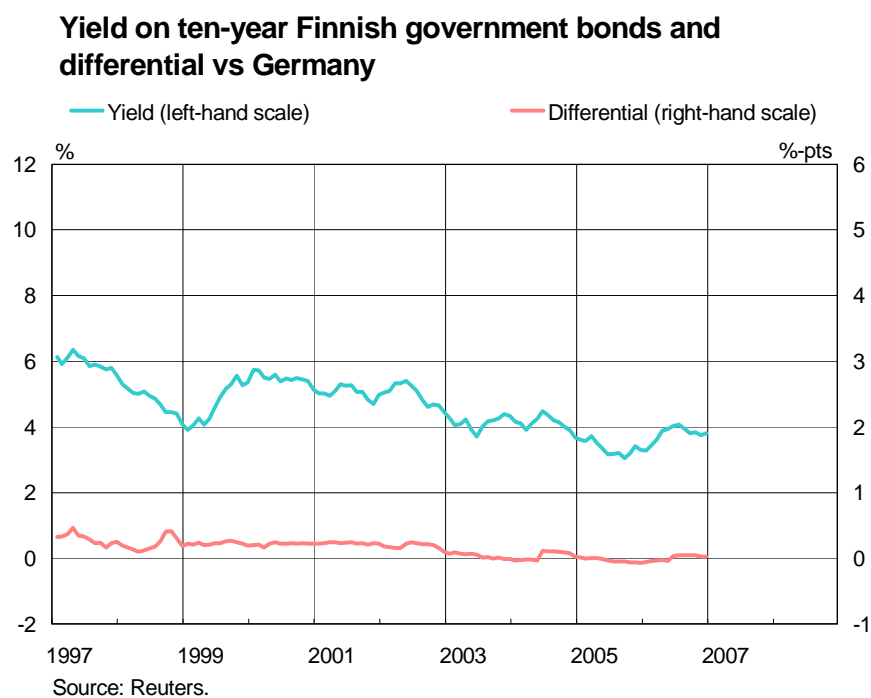
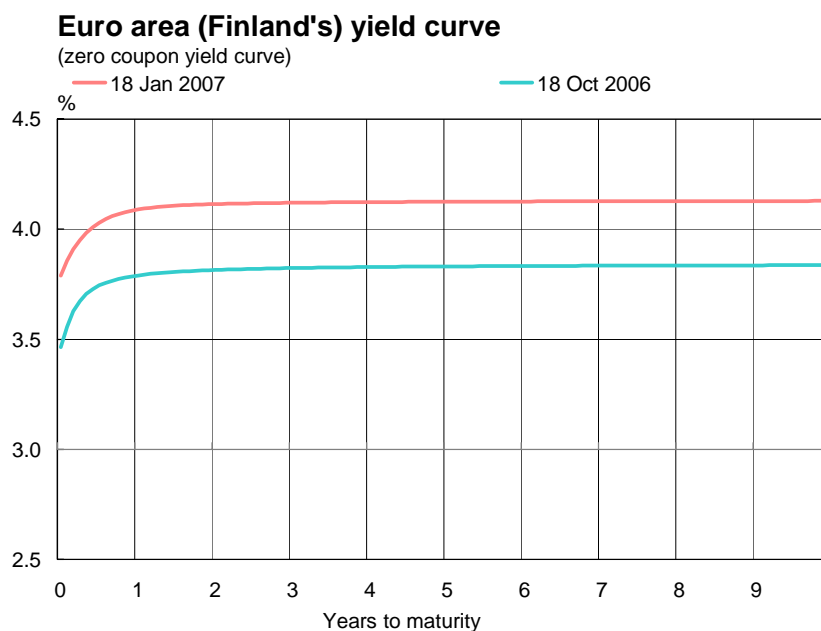

### Interest rates on loans and deposits

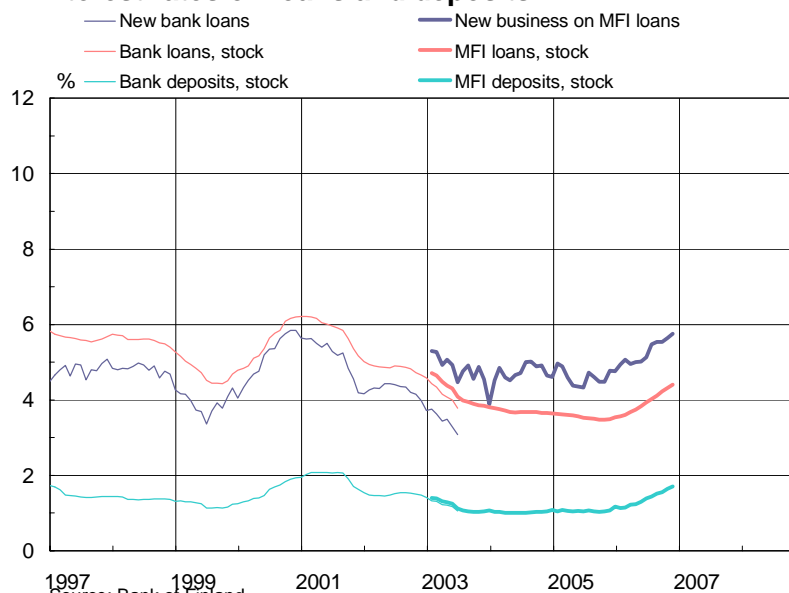

### Interest rates on new business to households

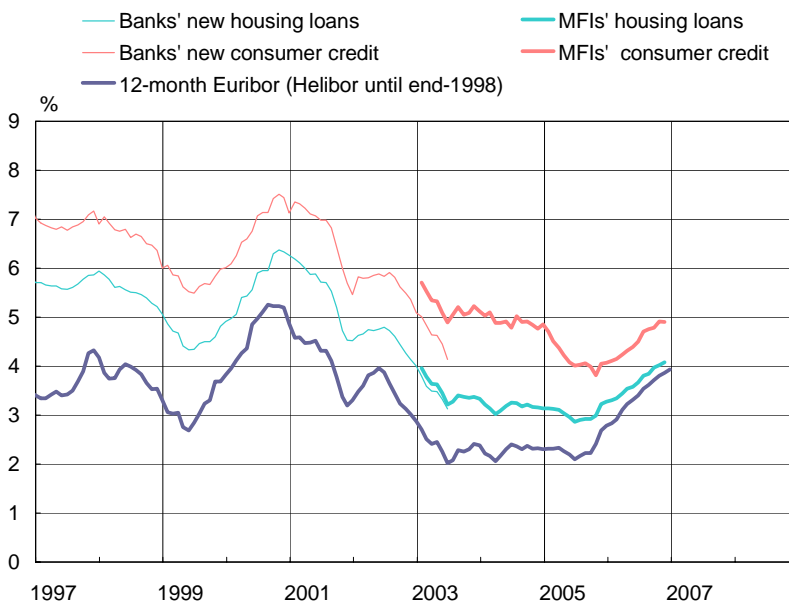

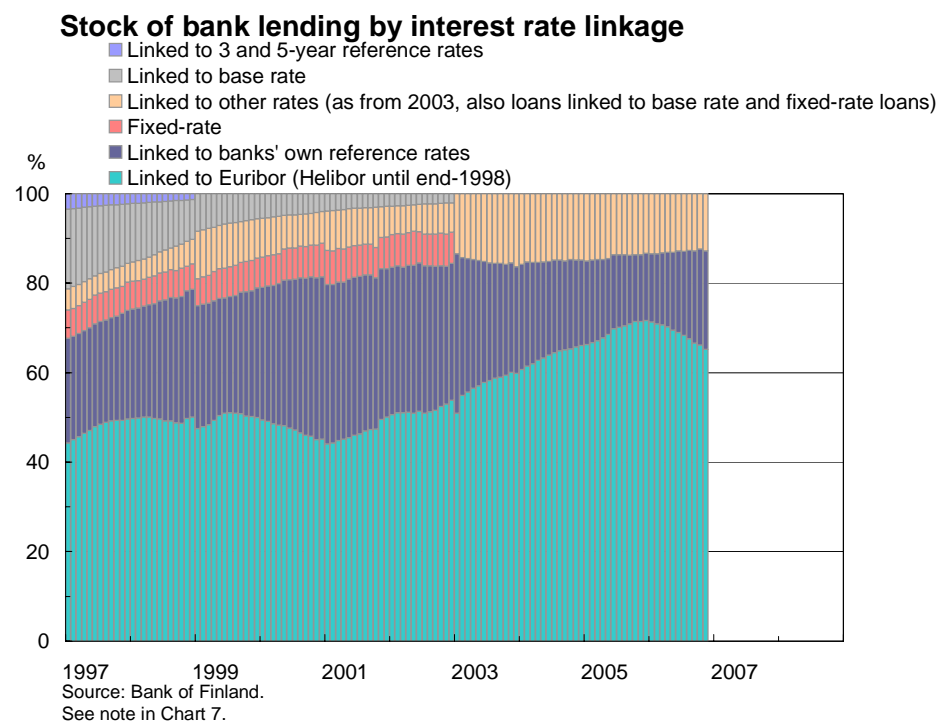

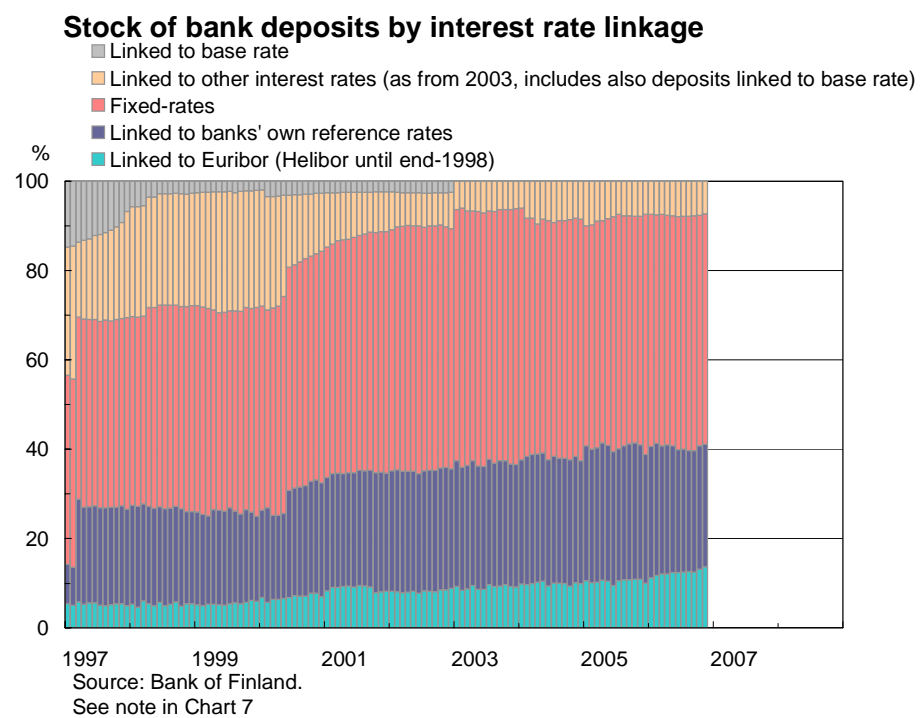

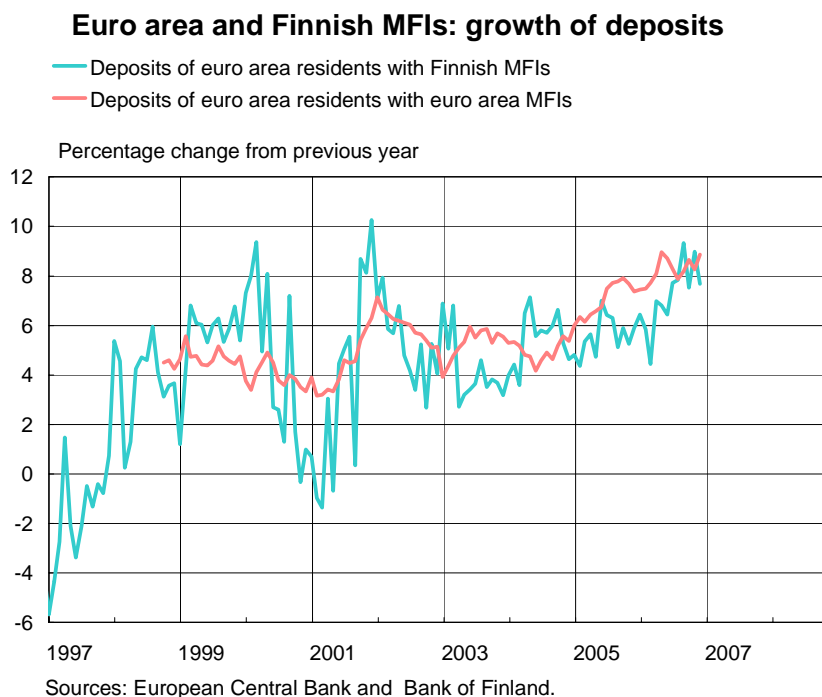

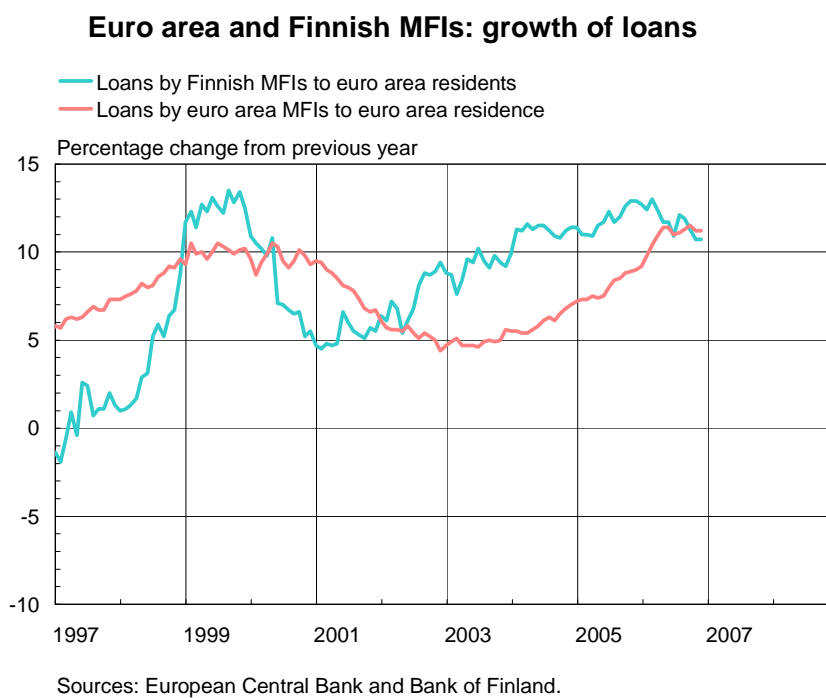
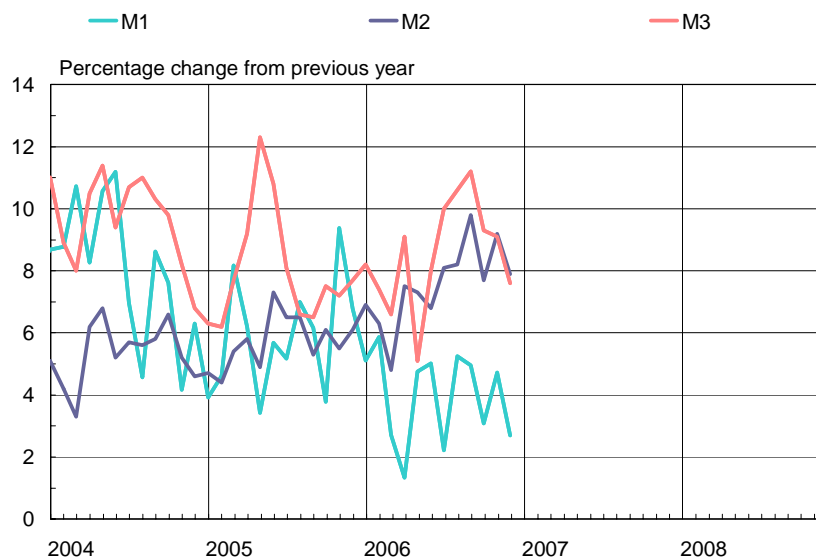

### Liabilities of Finnish monetary financial institutions included in monetary aggregates for the euro area \*

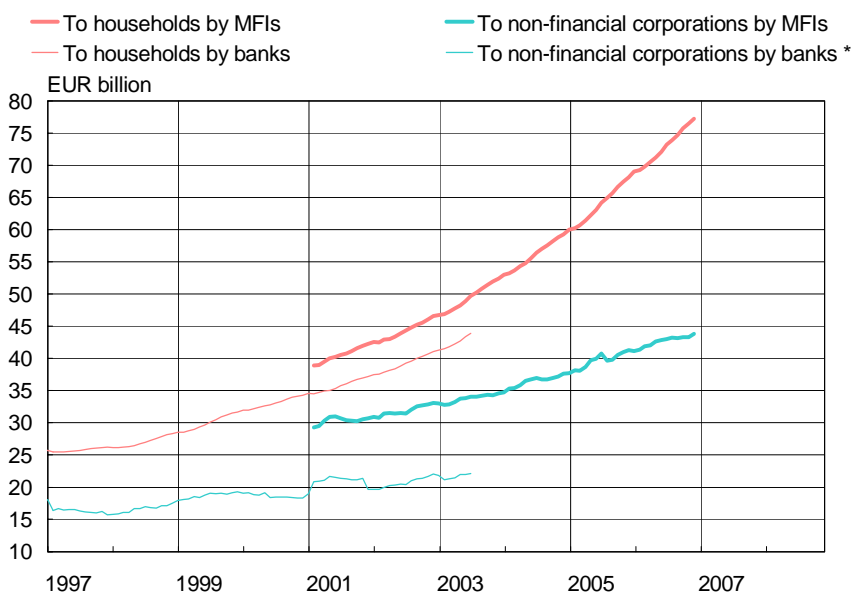

### Outstanding loans to households and non-financial corporations



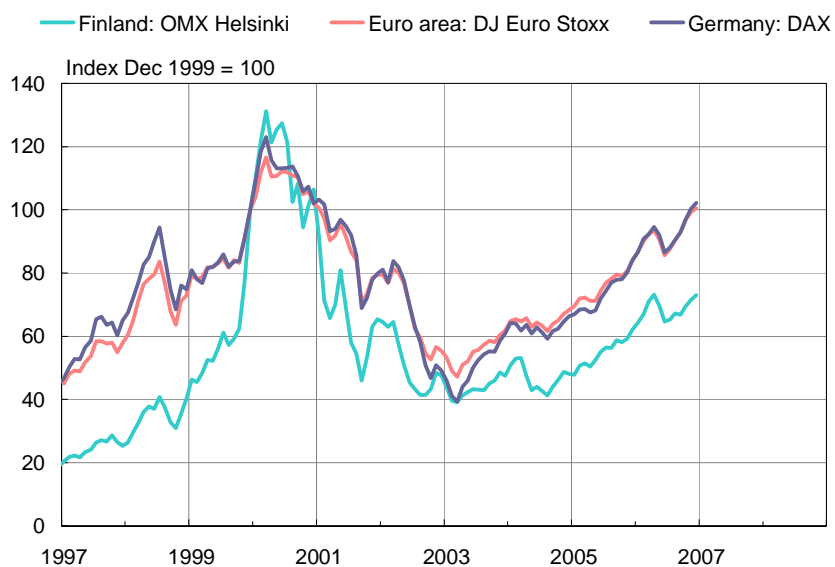

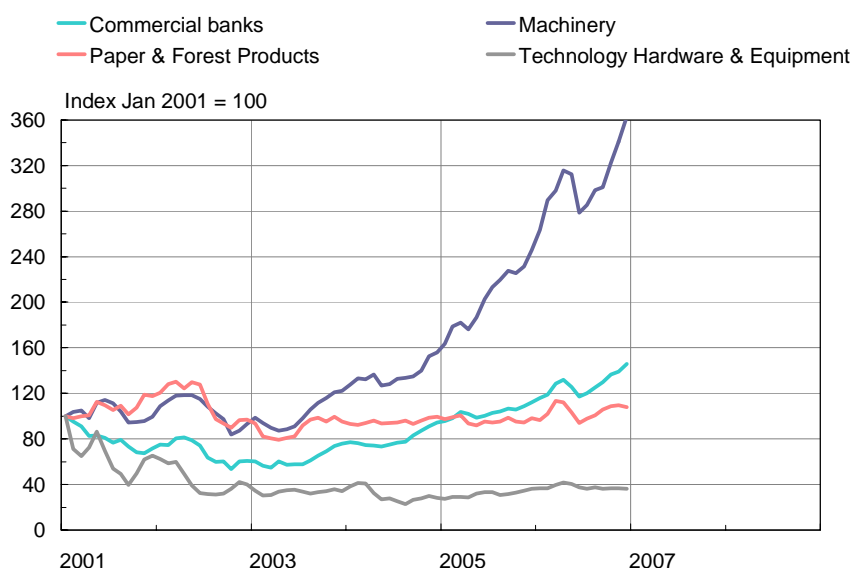
### Selected stock price indices in the euro area

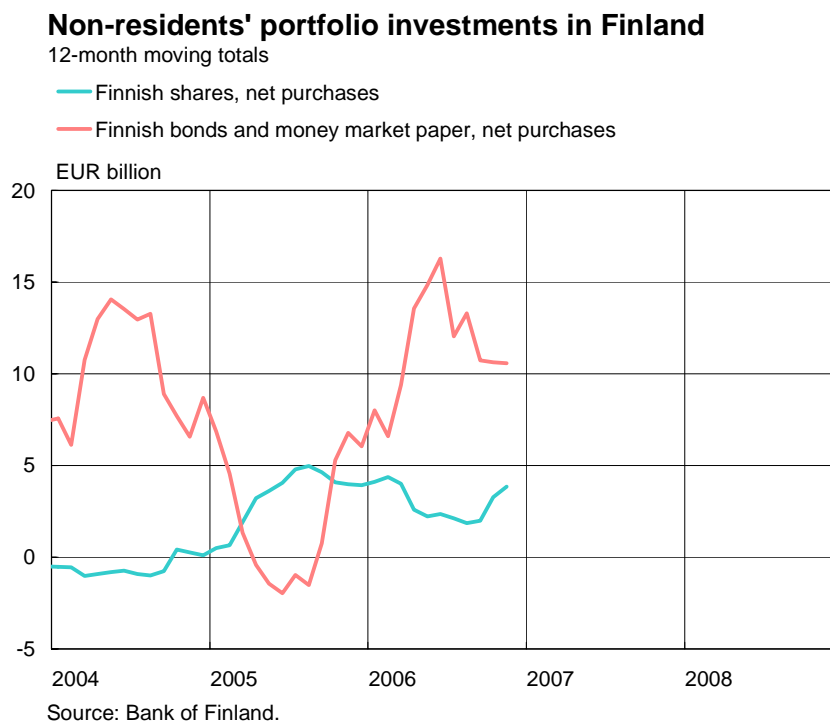

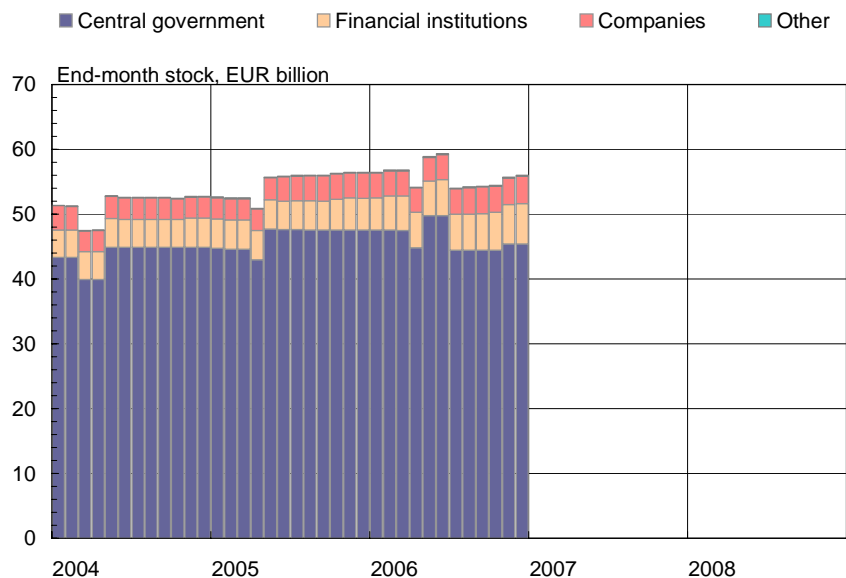
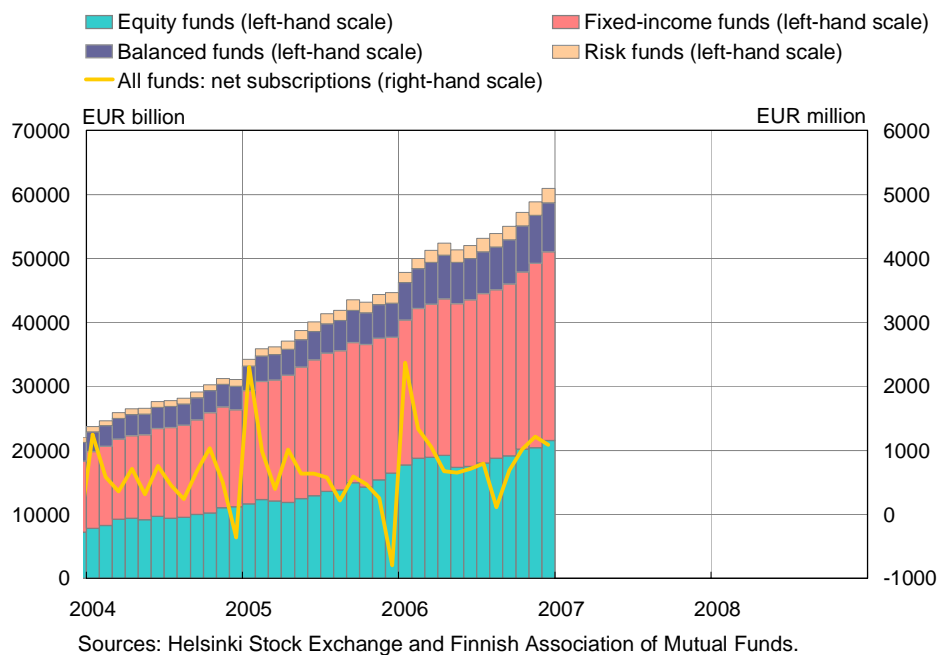

1 = corporate sector (excl. housing corporations), 2 = households.

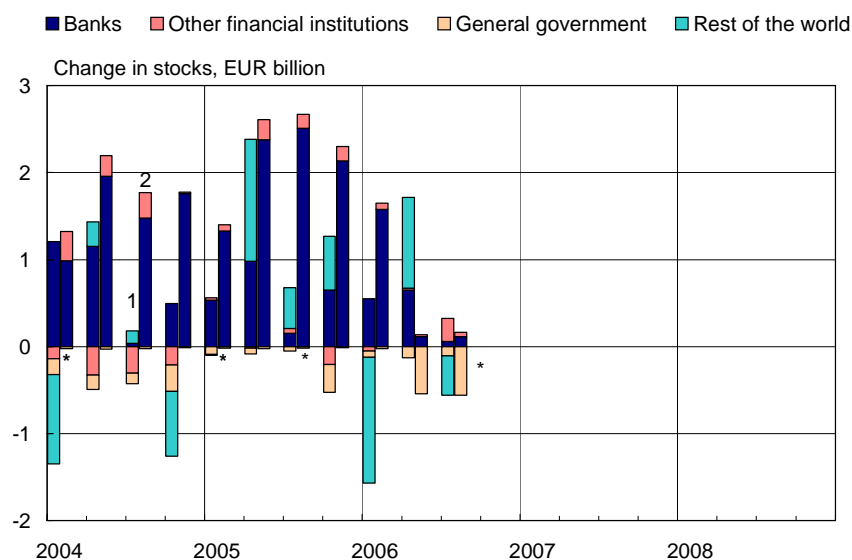
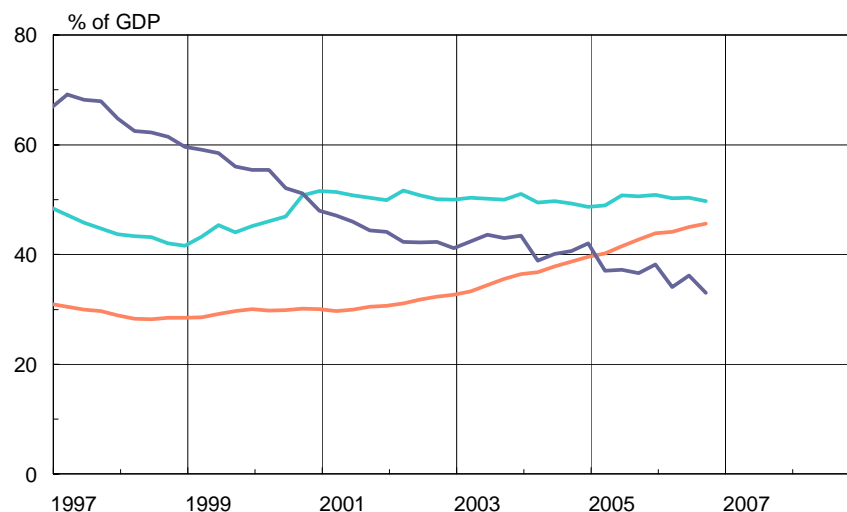

### Sectoral debt ratios in Finland

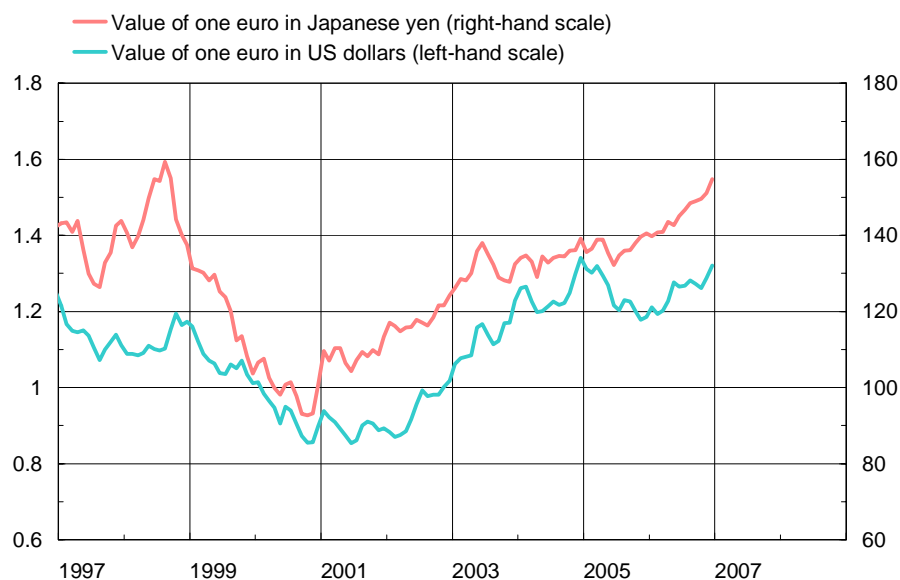
Non-financial corporate sector excl. housing corporations

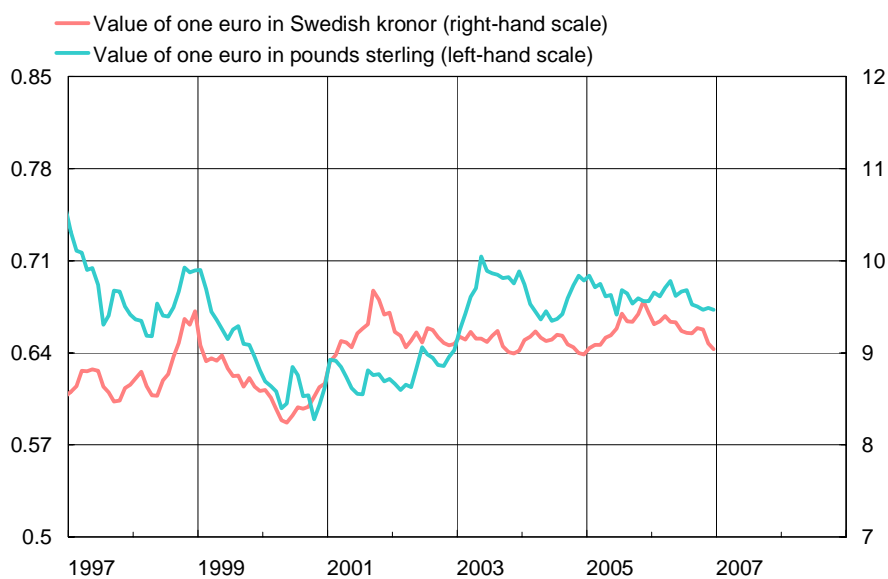
### Euro exchange rates against the US dollar and the yen

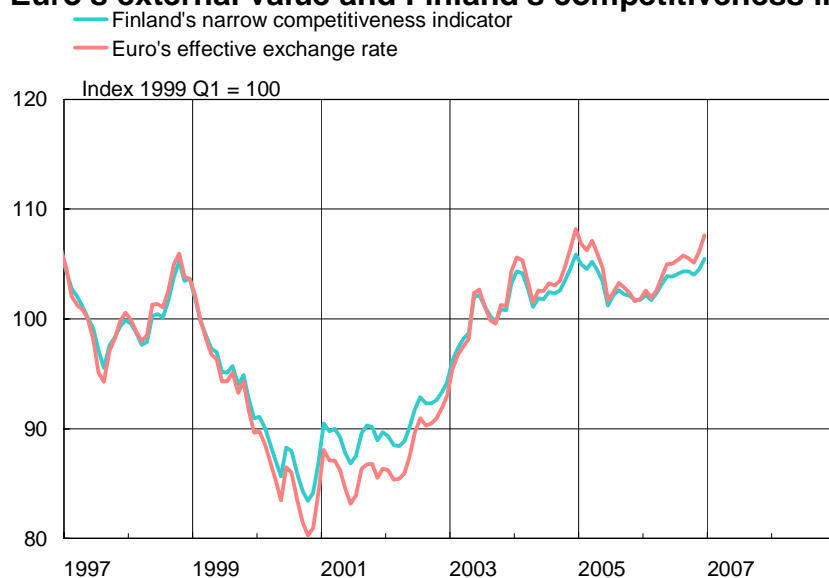
### Euro exchange rates against the pound sterling and the Swedish krona

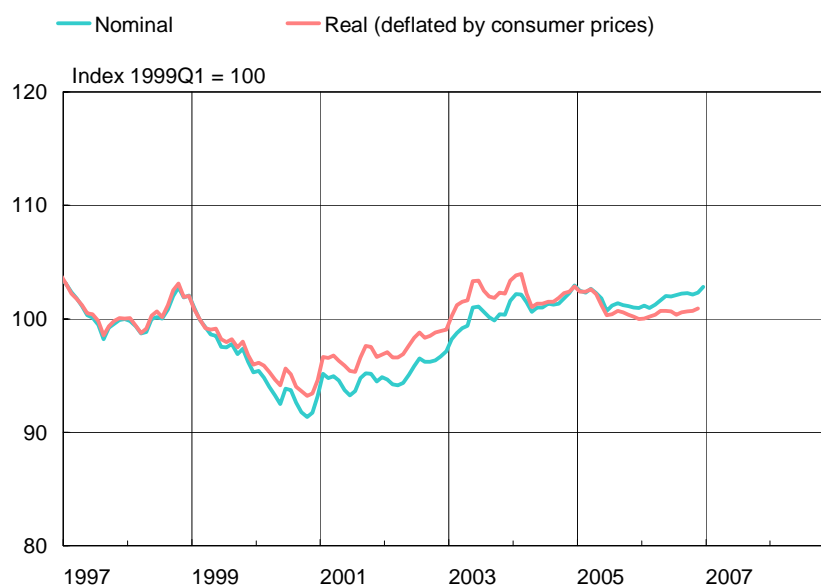

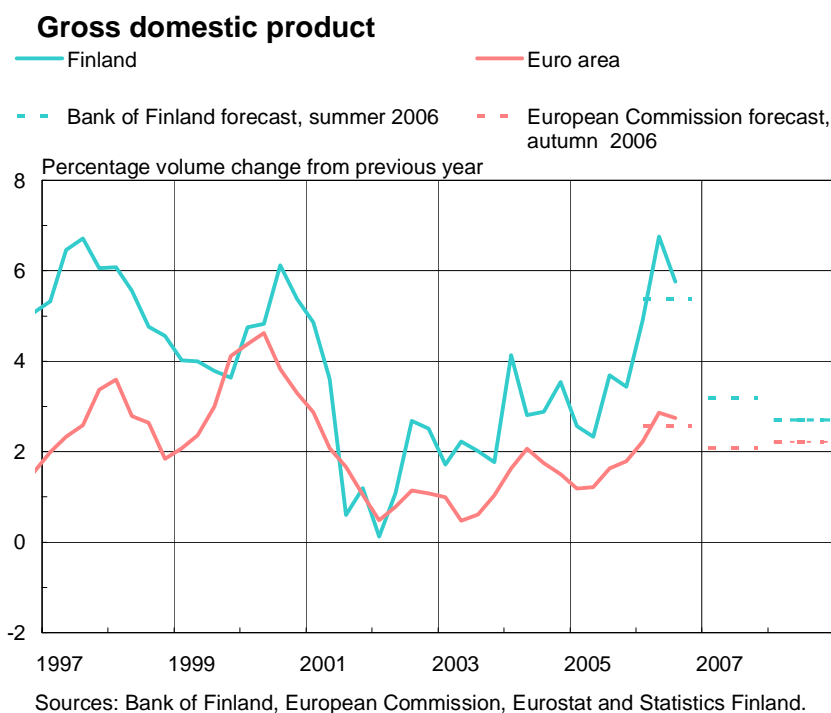

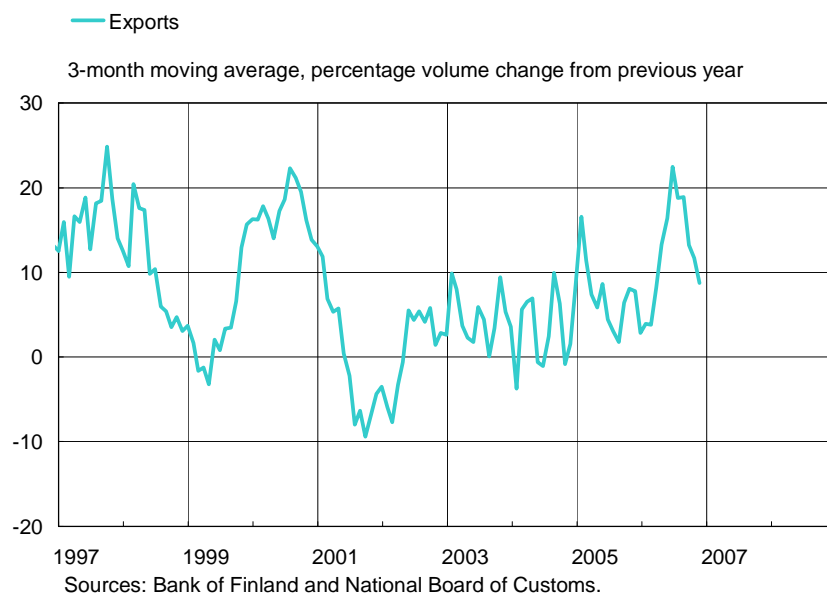
**Finland's exports of goods**

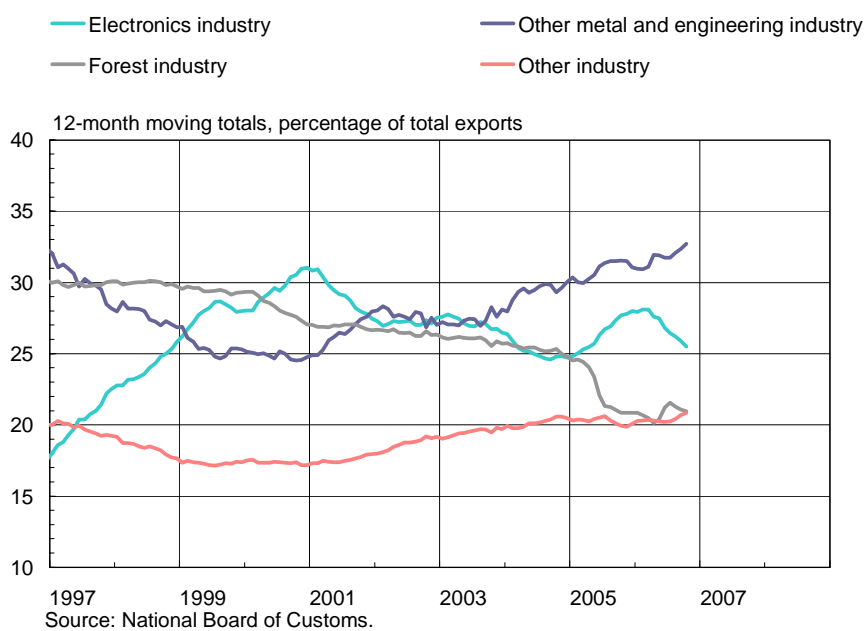

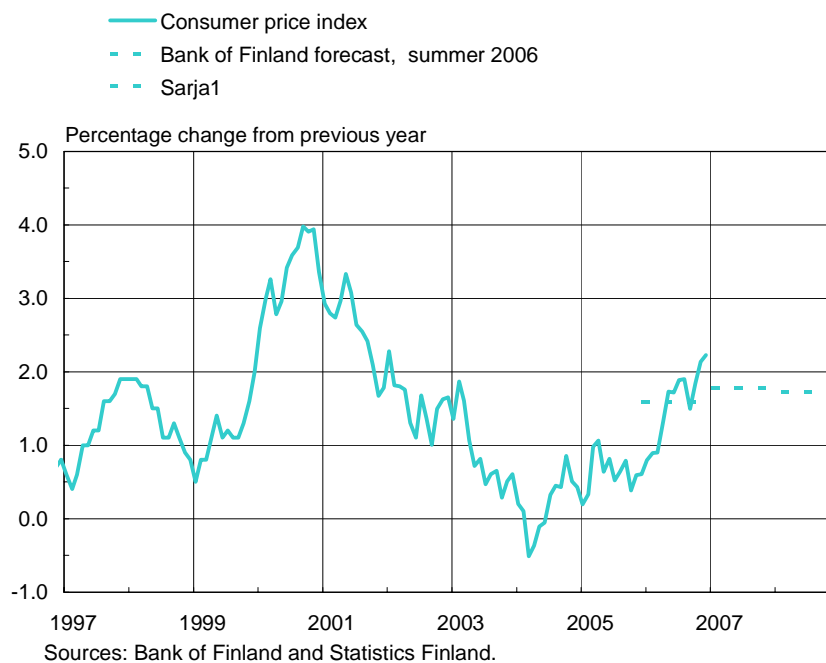

### Harmonized index of consumer prices (HICP)

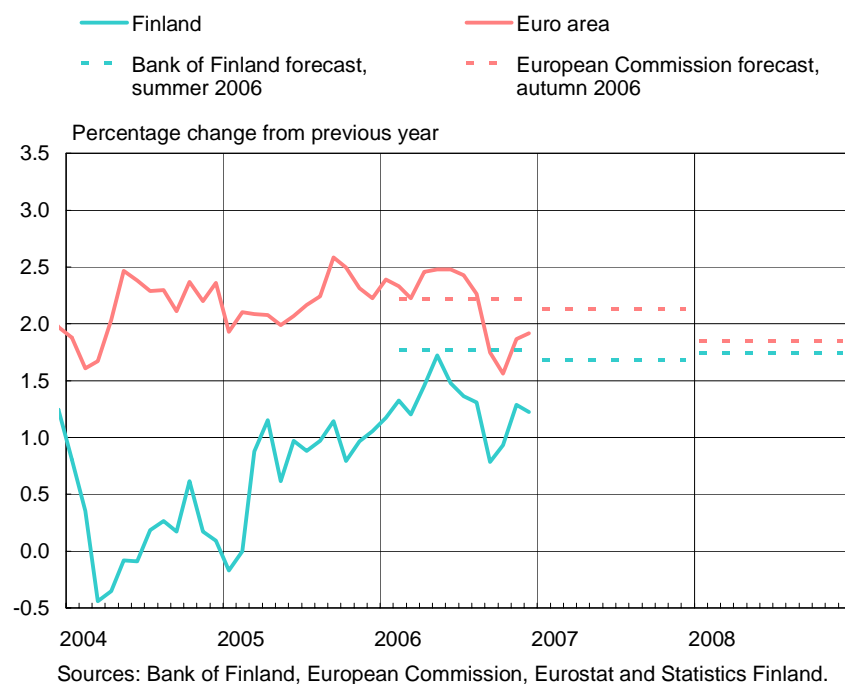
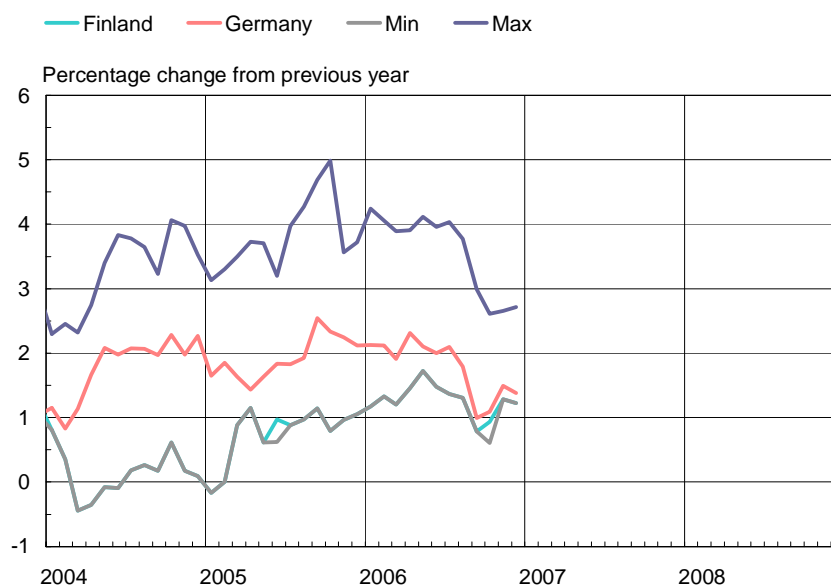
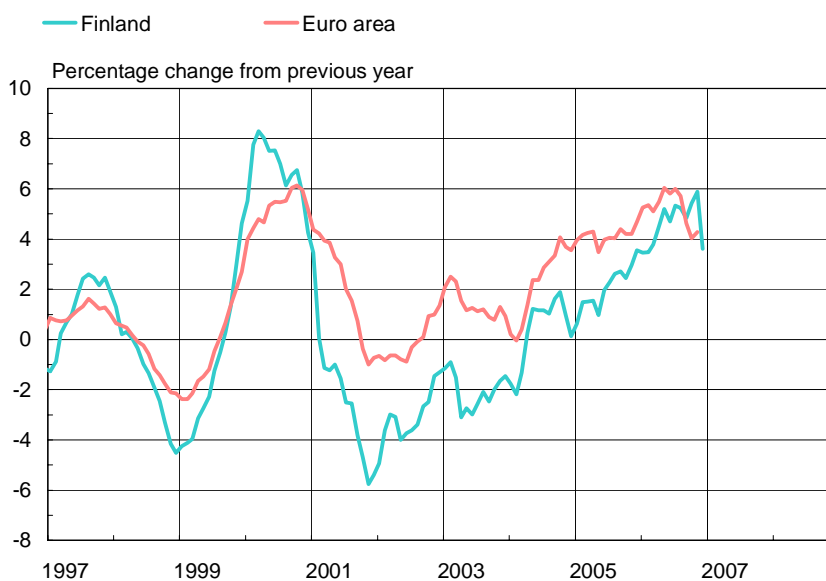

**Inflation rates in the euro area (HICP)**

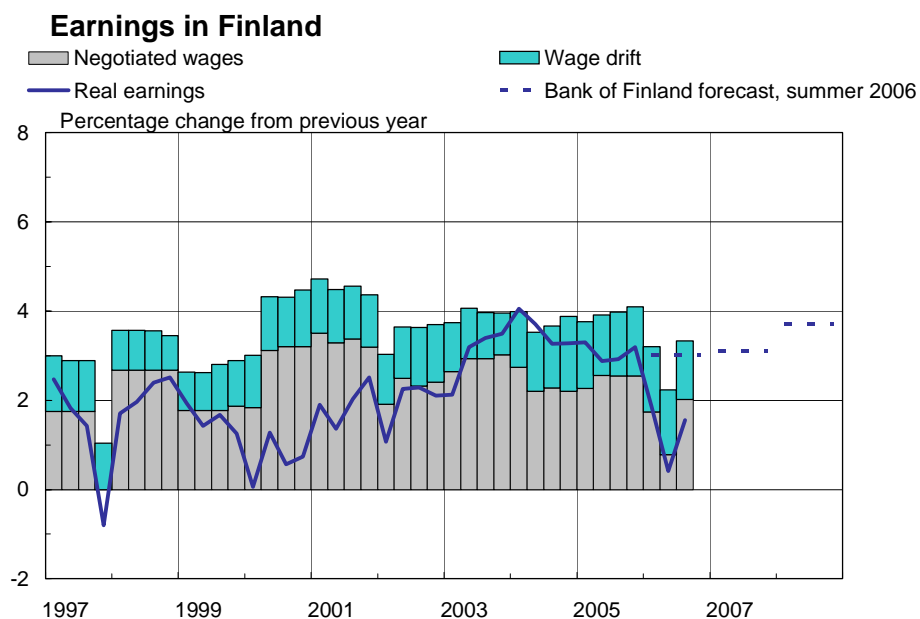

**Producer prices**

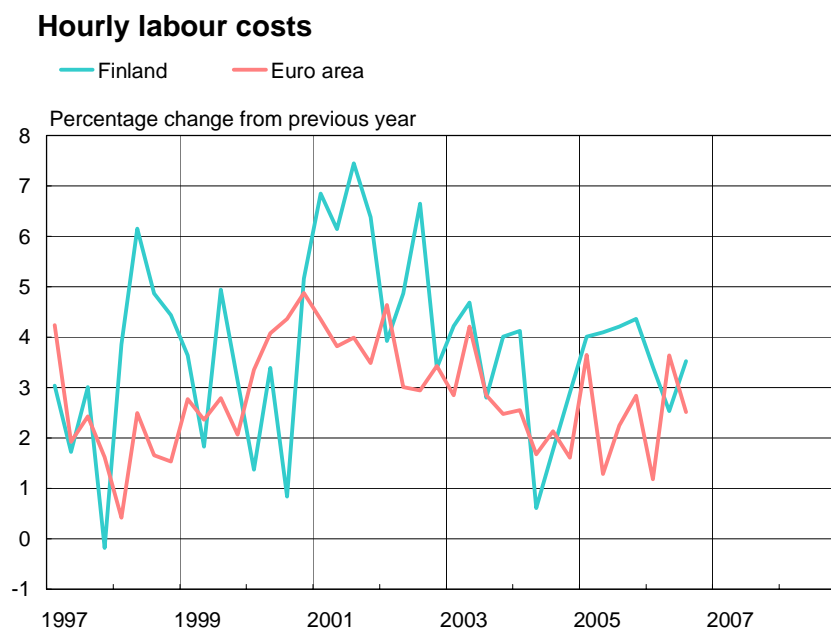

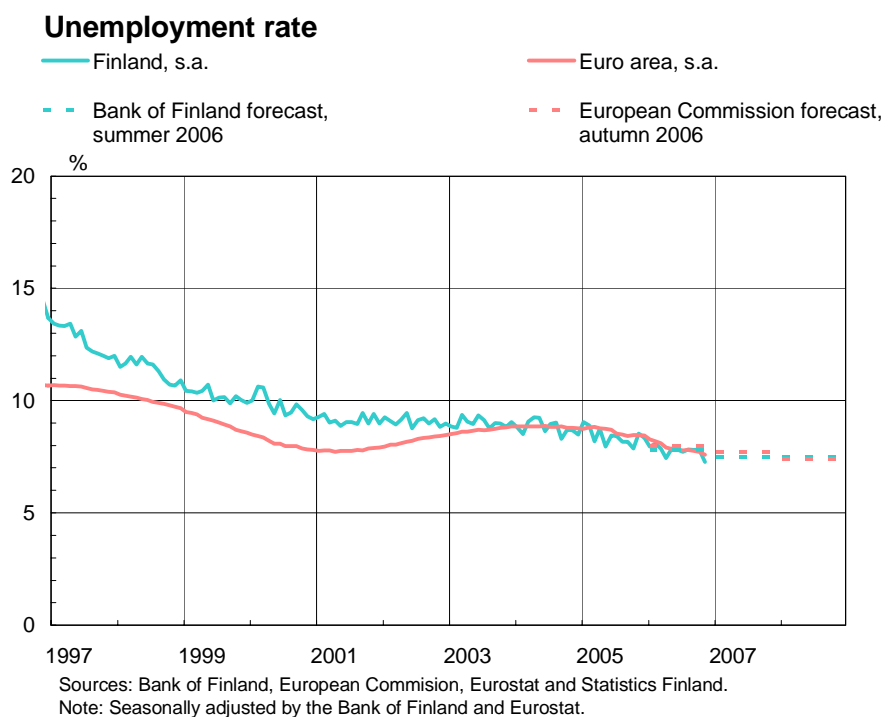
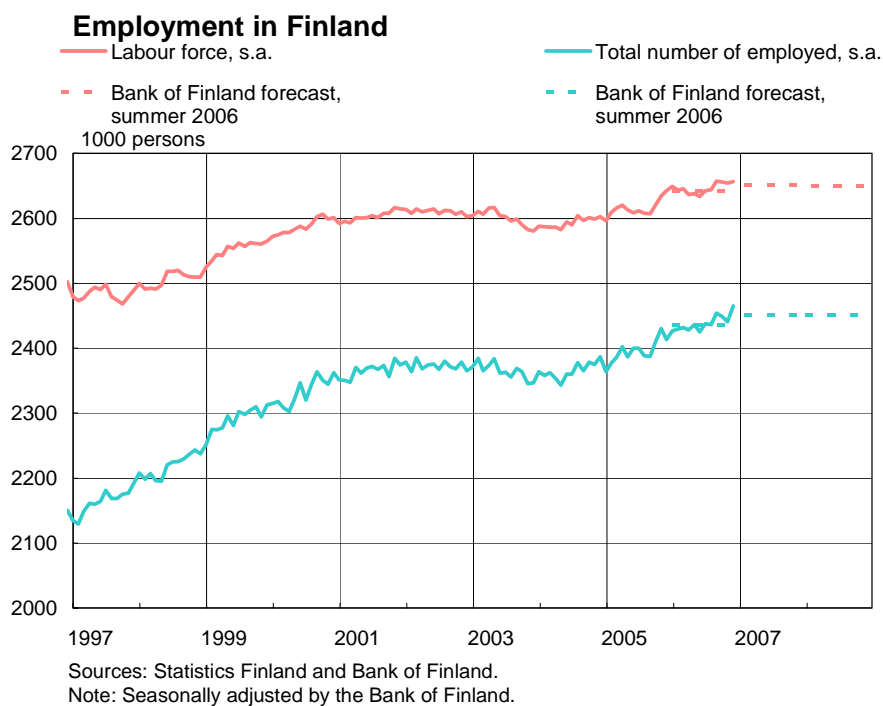

### Public sector balances in Finland

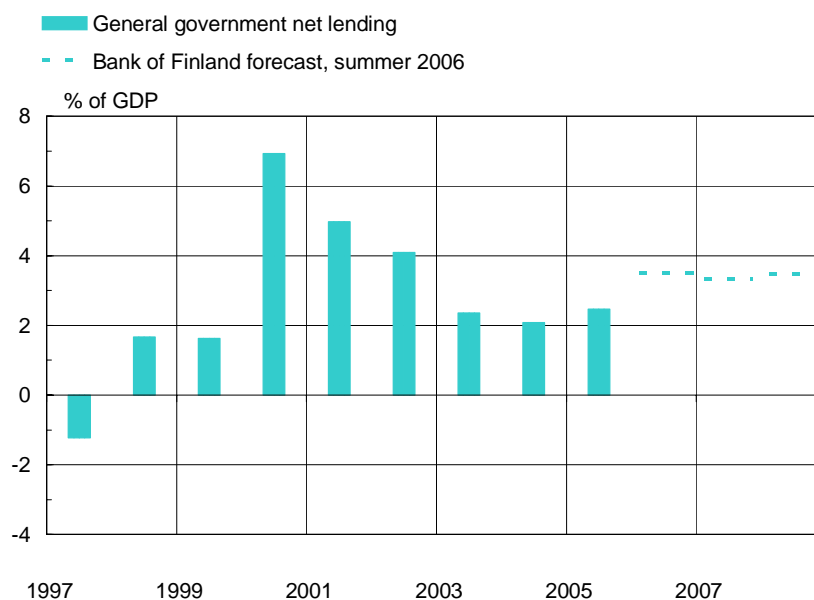
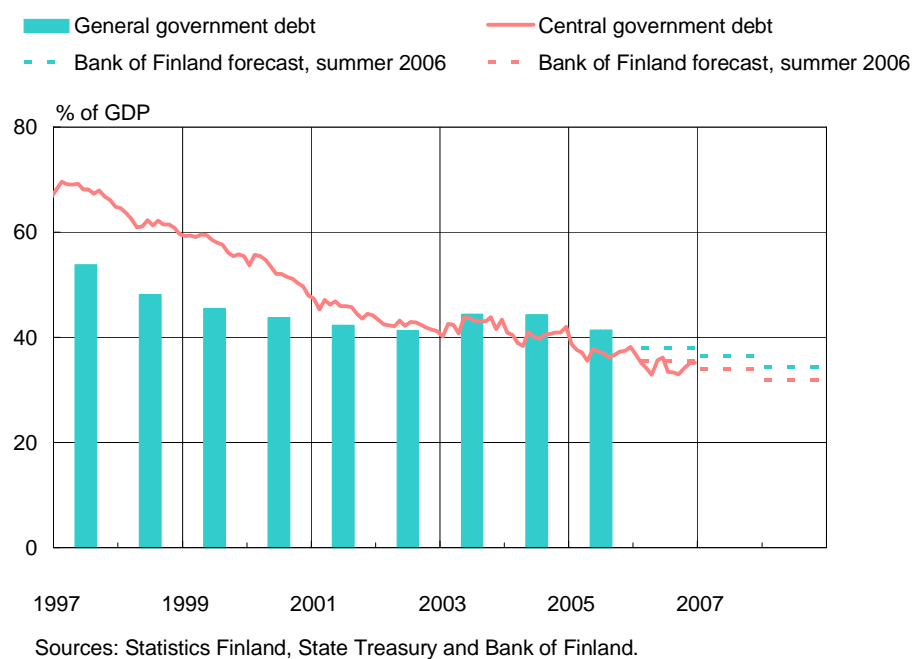

12-month moving totals

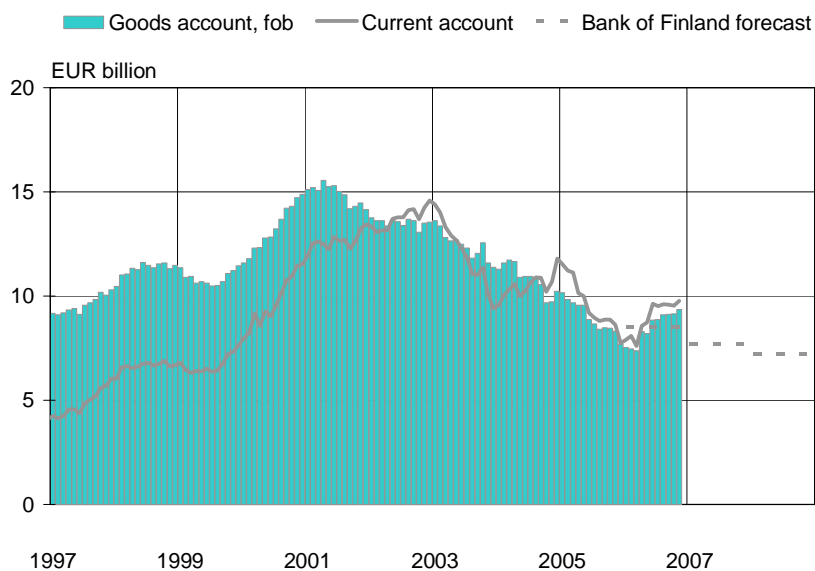

### Finland's net international investment position

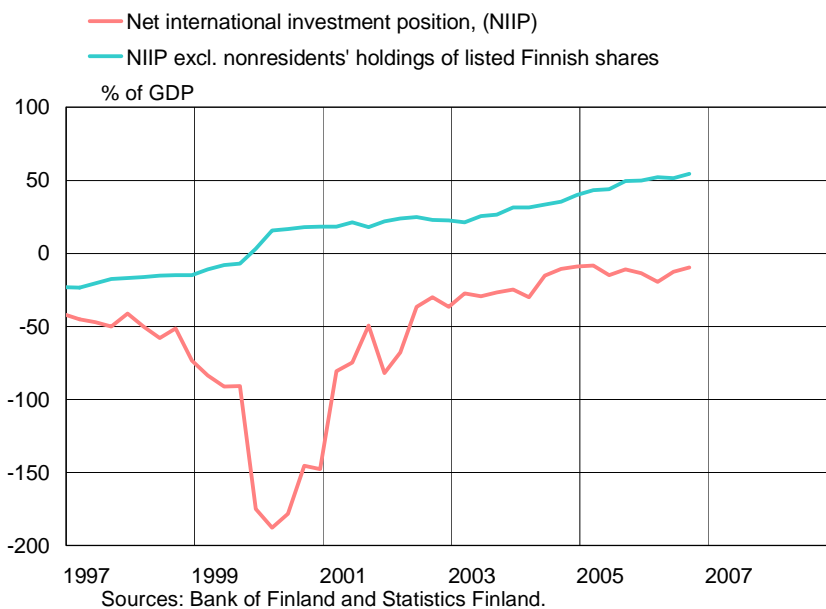
