






International three-month interest rates













#### Stock of bank deposits by interest rate linkage Linked to base rate

- Linked to banks' own reference rates % Linked to Euribor (Helibor until end-1998)







#### Outstanding loans to households and non-financial corporations

#### Helsinki Stock Exchange: share indices by sector



# Listed shares in Finland: total market capitalization and non-residents' holdings



- ---- Finnish bonds and money market paper, net purchases







1 = corporate sector (excl. housing corporations), 2 = households.





## Sectoral debt ratios in Finland

# Euro exchange rates against the pound sterling and the Swedish krona







## **Competitiveness indicators for Finland**







 Industrial investment prospects (percentage balance)









## Inflation rates in the euro area (HICP)







#### Hourly labour costs











