





# **Euribor rates**




# International three-month interest rates


## International long-term interest rates







-Deposits of euro area residents with euro area MFIs







## Euro area and Finnish MFIs: growth of loans





## Non-residents' portfolio investments in Finland





# Euro exchange rates against the pound sterling and the Swedish krona





## **Competitiveness indicators for Finland**





## Industrial confidence indicator





## Harmonized index of consumer prices (HICP)




## Hourly labour costs


