



"REPLYING YOUR CABLEGRAM WE ARE NOTIFIED BY CABLEGRAM FROM HUOTARI VIRKKI LAAKSOVIRTA AND EKSTEDT CALLING THEMSELVES PRESENT BOARD DIRECTORS FINLANDS BANK NOMINATED BY BANK TRUSTEES OF FINNISH PARLIAMENT AND CONFIRMED BY PRESENT GOVERNMENT FINLAND THAT OLD BOARD HAS BEEN DISCHARGED AND EXECUTION OF ITS ORDERS FORBIDDEN. STOP HAVE DONE NOTHING"
