In virtue of the Powers conferred upon them by the Royal Bank of Scotland Act, 1873, the Directors elected Field-Marshal the Right Hon. Earl Haig, K.T., G.C.B., O.M., G.C.V.O., K.C.I.E., as an Ordinary Director. Lord Haig holds office until this Annual General Court only, but is eligible for re-election.

The Governor, the Deputy-Governor, the Extraordinary Directors, and the Senior Ordinary Director (Mr Haldane) all retire at this time, but are eligible for re-election.

Auditors also fall to be appointed for the ensuing year, and Mr J. Maxtone Graham, C.A., and Mr Eric M. Beilby, C.A., offer themselves for re-election.
