Dear Mr. Ryti,

You will remember my visit to you when I was in Helsingfors a short time ago and you kindly gave me an interview with Mr. Jopson, Commercial Secretary of the British Embassy. I think I was able to interest you in showing some of our recent examples of Security Work, and I believe we were all agreed that the old Door of your Treasury which you have at present gives quite inadequate protection, in view of modern developments and scientific methods of attack. The installation of a modern Door, made to resist any attempt by explosives or the oxy-acetylene flame, would, I am sure, give you a greater degree of confidence in the protection of your bullion and ever increasingly valuable contents.

As Safemakers of long experience and world renowned reputation, we would strongly recommend your careful consideration of the three alternative estimates we now submit for the new Main Door and its corresponding Manhole or

Emergency Door.

Since my return, I have had many talks here and at our Works, and I would strongly recommend the first Door mentioned, of our MARK V. Quality, which is the same strength and thickness as the Doors we have supplied to the Bank of England, and many Head Offices of Banks here in London.

The second Door for which we quote, MARK V. Special, is of different construction and not quite so heavy as the Mark V. Quality. This is the Door which we have just supplied to the Nordiska Foreningsbanken: the finish would be painted, like the one supplied to the Bank's own Treasury, and not polished stainless steel finish as for the Safe Deposit.

The third Door for which we quote is of much lighter construction, MARK II with Crane Hinge.

The large Drawings sent with full size sections will readily show you the difference in the thicknesses of the three different qualities for which we quote.

May I mention something about the Chubb Tested Alloy, which we are offering in the Doors specified.
