Re: Finnish Guaranteed Municipal Loan of 1924

Hon. Risto Ryti, Governor, Finlands Bank, Helsingfors, Finland.

Dear Mr. Ryti:

We have just received here Assistant Vice-President Victor Schoepperle's November 18 letter relative to certain technicalities in the Contract of subject loan, and in view of the fact that I do not really at this time expect to see you in person until after the Christmas Holidays, I would very much appreciate it if you could expedite the execution of the Supplemental Agreement to the Loan Contract which Mr. Schoepperle sent me, as well as have the other points which he brings up attended to.

Relative to the amortization tables, you will remember that I was of the opinion that New York was to make these up. If you so prefer, I shall be glad definitely to request them to do so. In the case of the Finland Government Loan Contract of October 1923, New York furnished the amortization tables, and I took it for granted that they would do the same this time.

I assume that Mr. Wald. Toppelius, Notrary Public, will recognize my signature and will have no objection to affixing the same kind of a notarial certificate that he did to the original Loan Contract. Should he so desire, I know you will be glad to permit him to compare my signature with that found on the original Contract in your possession. I believe it would also be desirable to have the American Consul affix his certificate to the copy to be sent New York, the same as was done in the case of the original Contract.

I trust that this matter of additional "technicalities" will not cause you too much trouble. If Mr. Ilves, our Attorney, can be of any assistance to you, I am sure that he will be glad to help if you will be good

Page 2 of "Gen 1249/24", December 1, 1924 enough to telephone him. I am not personally writing Mr. Ilves because I do not know whether it will prove necessary for you to ask for his assistance.

Finally, I would request that you please send the Supplemental Agreement to the Loan Contract to me here, as well as the other information and material required by Mr. Schoepperle, so that I may have copies made not only for our files here, but also for the associated Municipalities, the City of Helsingfors, and the Finnish Government. These copies I shall be glad to send you when completed for distribution.
