Representative of The National City Bank of New York,

Dear Sir:

We beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of June 6, 1929, together with a draft of agreement concerning the renewal for six months of the City of Helsingfors' six months \$4,000,000:- Revolving Credit expiring June 30. We enclose the Agreement in 4 copies and beg to draw your attention to the fact that this Agreement is signed by the Vice-President of the Financial Committee Mr. Väinö Hupli and the Secretary of the said Committee Mr. Torsten Törnblom, instead of Messrs. Arthur Castrén and Mauno Wilskman, which both now are abroad. In compliance with your request we have handed over a copy of the Agreement to Mr. Ilves.

We have further with satisfaction noticed your opinion as to the possibility of a further renewal of the Credit in case it should not be possible to market a long term loan before the maturity of the Credit.
