Finnish Loan Rumored

There was a well defined rumor in the banking community yesterday to the effect that a large investment house is negotiating with the government of Finland on a bond issue. The fact that Dr. Riddy, financial representative of Finland, is here lent color to the report. In the absence of any inclination on the part of the banking house in question to discuss the matter it was assumed that the loan, if one is actually floated, will take the place of the exchange stabilization fund which the National City Bank gave to Finland last year and which was extended a few weeks ago. The amount mentioned runs up to \$10,000,000.
